Immediate Enrollment of Students displaced by recent Natural Disasters (Earthquake, Hurricanes, Forest Fires)

OVERVIEW

- Families looking to register their children arriving from one of the impacted areas – **please register**
- Have them sign the McKinney Vento form.
- Gather whatever information/documents that may have with them; an example: make a copy of **Boarding Pass or Letter from Agency** that has helped them evacuate.
- **Elementary students** – work with the families identifying the grade and school last attended and where located; **ask if student had an IEP and contact Bilingual Dept. to determine school placement.**
- **High School students-** place students in grade that the parent/child are stating; identify the last school attended – we will work on obtaining school transcripts; **ask if student had an IEP and contact Bilingual Dept. to determine school placement.**
- Immediately refer to school FOC or School Social Worker.
