Parents and the community are invited to visit the health fair vendors for Blood Pressure, Cholesterol, and Diabetes screening. Also available will be eye exams, nutrition counseling and dancing for health activities. Confirmed health care vendors like Cooper Hospital, Camden Area Health Education Center (AHEC), Rutgers Cooperative Extension, Dr. Kelly Molock (Optometrist), Hispanic Family Health Center, Lighthouse Hospice, Camden County Health Department, Gift of Life (organ donation), Healthy Mothers Healthy Babies, Osborn Family Center, Concord Health and Rehab, Moorestown Visiting Nurses and Dr. McGunnigle (Chiropractor) will be on hand to speak with attendees about health concerns. Horizon New Jersey Health Care will provide insurance information and a “Dancing For Your Health” presentation with a DJ and line dancing.

Ninth grade students were assigned a different health care career to research for a Health Careers Poster Contest. Student artwork (posters) will be displayed throughout the school during the fair and winners will be notified prior to an awards assembly at the end of the year. The school’s mission is to educate students about health care issues and careers in health care. This event is part of the school’s outreach program to parents and the Camden Community.
