At Camden High School's athletic field next Monday, Liverpool Football Club's coaching staff will lead three one-hour skill-building clinics, open to boys and girls ages 4 – 14. The sessions begin at 4:30, 5:30, and 6:30 p.m. Families are encouraged to register their children in advance, as space is limited and spots are filling up quickly.

"I know from personal experience that playing soccer is a great way for kids to learn team work and self-discipline, and to build confidence," Camden City School District Superintendent Paymon Rouhanifard said. "It is an honor to be hosting Liverpool Football Club at Camden High School next Monday evening. I encourage both new and experienced soccer players to come out and participate in this free summer skill-building camp."

The Liverpool Foundation works around the world to introduce young people to the game of soccer, and to provide coaching and training to kids from low-income or otherwise disadvantaged communities. The Foundation's goal is to provide tailored programs that inspire positive change and build better futures for young people and adults.
